In the meantime and in accordance with our statutory powers as referred to in my first letter, I enclose Notices under Section 8 and Section 13 of the British Waterways Acts 1983 and 1971, respectively. Kindly acknowledge safe receipt and I enclose a stamped addressed envelope for your use.

I believe that my previous letters and this letter sets out our position clearly but if you have any problems please do not hesitate to contact me.

Finally, please note that a copy of this letter is also being delivered to your boat.
